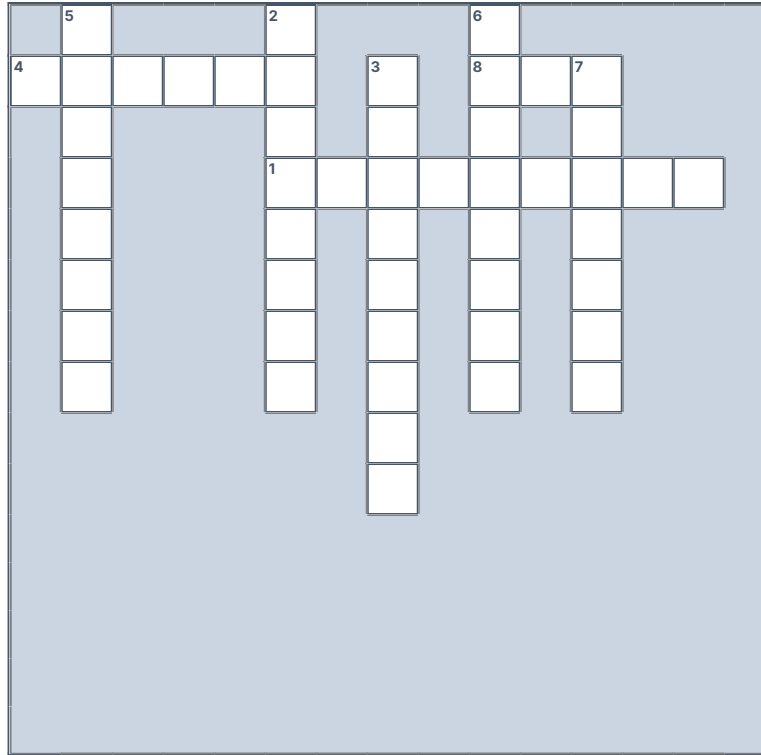

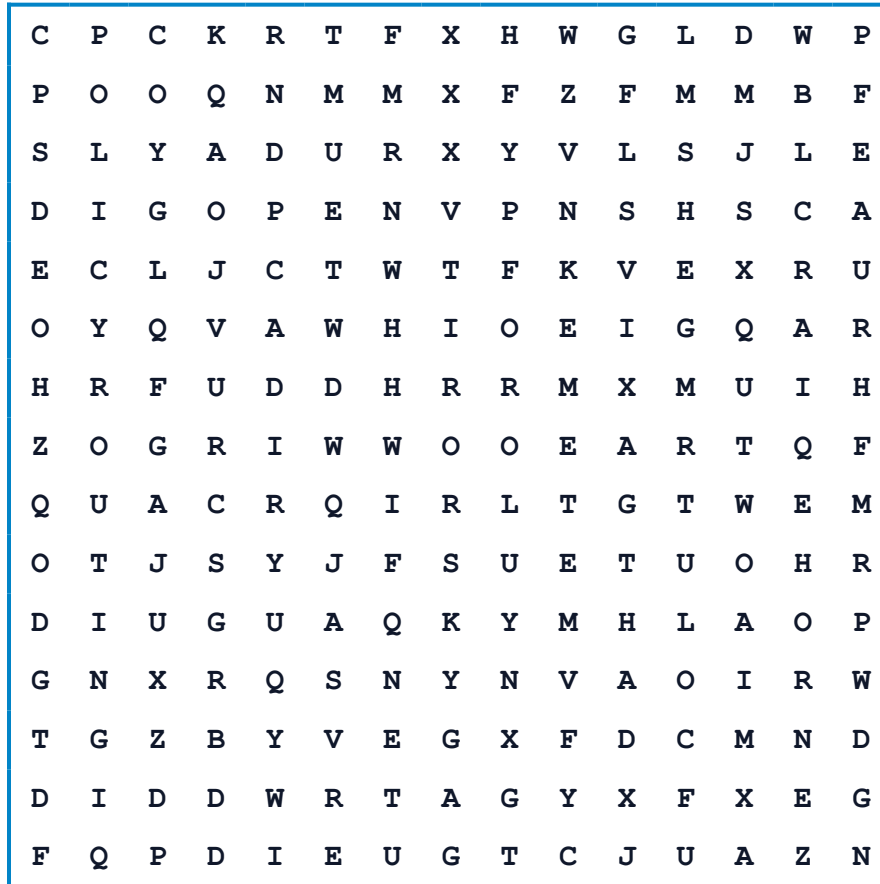

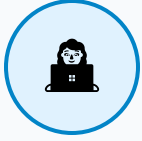

Scenario: A smart home has over 30 connected devices, including unencrypted security cameras and smart thermostats.
